

Octagon House Health and Safety Plan

In Compliance with SFPD Directives and Recommended Guidelines for Museums in SF

We are looking forward to welcoming visitors back for tours of Octagon House. The health and safety of our guests and docents is our top priority. We have initiated some extra safety measures to ensure that your visit will be as comfortable as possible:

1. Increased air flow and circulation with multiple windows open throughout the House.
2. Hand sanitizer available upon entry to the House.
3. LIMITED CAPACITY will be followed with no more than 8 in the house at one time.

Guidelines For Your Visit

- A. Stay home if you are sick.**
- B. Masks must be worn by all docents and visitors over 2 years of age.** If guests need a mask, one will be offered. Visitors who refuse to wear a face covering, will be denied entry.
- C. Maintain social distancing of 6 ft**
- D. Visitors may not touch any object or furniture in the house,** except the handrail when climbing up or down the stairs.
- E. Food and beverages are not permitted inside.**
- F. Due to constraints, no restroom is available to the public; please plan accordingly.**
