<u>Treasurer:</u> Margie Martin reported the opening balance total checking as of 4/1/2023 is \$20,389.23. She stated that \$560.00 is dedicated from the Patriotic Fund to the Weeks House; pending their commitment to a specific project.

Margie made a motion to transfer \$1,000 from the Administrative Fund to the Patriotic Fund. A vote was approved unanimously.

Balance of checking account is \$20,512.70 as of 4/30/2023. The full report is filed with the Minutes.

<u>Patriotic Services:</u> Susan Clark reported that Town Committees are awaiting specific guidelines from NSCDA re: the Museum Alliance Grant Application process. A Grant needs to be written to justify what amount each Committee will be granted. Our goal is to help support the Weeks House/Boronda Adobe. Ruben Mendoza may help in writing the grant request for our Committee to go forward with the application once received by National.

Wreaths Across America was discussed for our November/December project. Last year we grouped with DAR at the last minute to support a contribution of 17 wreaths to lay at the Veteran's gravesites. This year, we plan to commit the Monterey Peninsula Committee Colonial Dames on our own as a sponsor. We will donate \$340.00 to purchase 20 wreaths. More information will follow after we establish our official Commitment to Wreaths Across America.

The Patriotic Services monthly calendar is in the planning stages for September 2023 through March 2024. The full Report is filed with the Minutes.

<u>Membership:</u> Marcia Harrington reported there are (49) current members (Includes 6 non-resident Members); (1) Courtesy Member; and (8) potential Prospective Candidates since March 23, 2023. A full report is filed with the Minutes.

<u>Webmaster</u>: Marguerite Meyer reported she has posted end of the year photos and events to include February through March 2023.
