PROGRAM Professor Emeritus Susan Shillinglaw will present about John Steinbeck. Dr. Shillinglaw graduated with a B.A. in English and Art from Cornell College and earned a Ph.D. in English from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. Since 1984, she has been a Professor of English at San Jose State University (currently FERPing), where she was Director of the University's Center for Steinbeck Studies for



18 years. She was also Director of the National Steinbeck Center in Salinas from 2015-18.

Dr. Shillinglaw has published widely on John Steinbeck, most recently Carol and John Steinbeck: Portrait of a Marriage, On Reading The Grapes of Wrath; and A Journey into Steinbeck's California. Currently, she is writing a book about Steinbeck's landscapes. She has also served on the boards of Hopkins Marine Station, the Cannery Row Foundation, SJSU's Center for Steinbeck Studies, the National Steinbeck Center, the Monterey Museum of Art, and the Western Flyer Foundation.
